Registering allows your child/ren to set their own goals and also provides a bounty of great resources such as skipping videos to challenge their skills.


#### Mobile Phone Policy

A friendly reminder of our mobile phone policy which is in line with the DOBCEL Digital Technologies Policy & Agreement:

- Phones/devices must not be brought to school and if for any reason they are, they are to remain in the students bag at all times.
- Students are not permitted to use phones/devices on school
- If the phone/device is brought to school, it is the full responsibility of the child/parents if it is lost, damaged or
- Failure to meet these requirements will see the phone/device removed from the student and held at the school office until the end of the school day. The school will inform parents of the breach and the school may decide to not permit the device be brought to school for a period of time.

As the student is unable to use or access their phone during the school day, all communication must go directly through the school.

#### Winter Uniform Reminder

With the weather cooling down, we are now headed into winter uniform territory. With this in mind, we wish to remind families of the following sections of our uniform policy:

- Please ensure your child is wearing navy pants to school and a school jumper and/or jacket. Where possible the pants need to be the dark "ink" navy in colour. Plain pants are preferable however, if branding is visible it must be discreet. Sports leggings are not considered school uniform. If you would like support in sourcing new uniform items, please contact the school as we have some stock and second hand items available.
- Being Term 2, students are not required to wear hats at play time.
- Students with shoulder length hair or longer are required to have it tied back (safteu reasons).
- Please keep hair accessories to school colours (blue, red or white).
- Jewellery is not permitted to be worn at school. With the exception of basic studs and sleeper earrings, as there is a reduced risk of them accidentally getting hooked or pulled, lost or broken.

In the coming weeks we will be doing a uniform blitz. If your child is out of uniform or wearing additional accessories they will be asked to remove the item. If they are wearing them for a particular reason, just send a text to the school.








#### Mini Vinnies
