Pentecost is a very sacred and special time in the Bible when the disciples received the gift of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost took place 50 days after Jesus rose from the dead. The story in Acts 2:1-42 tells how the early followers of Christ came together on Pentecost.

Pentecost is actually a Jewish holiday, also called Shavuot, that happened 50 days after Passover. The birth of the Christian church happened in the middle of a Jewish festival that remembered God's aift of the Torah to Moses on Mt. Sinai and honored the harvest season



What is National Sorry Day? RECONCILIATION




